#### Abstract

#### Background

With the drug epidemic continuing to be a long-standing problem among all social classes, alternative sources of care must be devised in order to prevent the rising cases of drug associated mortality. Harm reduction programs aim to fill that role by offering progressive treatments that can hinder drug associated consequences. However, there are a multitude of problems that people who deserve this treatment experience during their search to remedy this spreading disease.

#### Purpose

The purpose of this study is to help bring awareness to the significant lack of information revolving around the idea of harm reduction interventions. This study will mainly focus on the upper and middle class, therefore, the end goal is to gain insight on what exactly deters or dissuades this specific population from gaining care. #### Study Methods & Setting

#### Hypothesis


What are causing upper and middle class drug dependents to dismiss harm reduction interventions as options for care and what are some solutions to said barriers?




