Lynn Sondag, chair of Dominican's Department of Art, Art History and Design, exhibited her landscape paintings at "The Presidio – Start Here: Explore, Play, Learn in a New Kind of National Park" through September 24, 2015 in the main branch of the San Francisco Public Library.
