Jack and Suzy Welch speak in spring author series

Retired General Electric Company CEO Jack Welch and his wife and co-author, Suzy, spoke at Dominican University of California on May 14 at the Institute for Leadership Studies' Spring Author Series, presented in partnership with Book Passage.

They appeared in conversation with Steve Bennett, who served key management roles at GE for 23 years.

Jack, who was chief executive officer at GE from 1981-2001, and Suzy, a journalist and author, discussed their book, *The Real-Life MBA: Your No-BS Guide to Winning the Game, Building a Team, and Growing Your Career*.

Suzy is a television commentator, business journalist, and author of the bestselling book, 10-10-10: A Life Transforming Idea. The former editor of Harvard Business Review, Suzy attended Harvard University and Harvard Business School.
